Atten: Jr. Iditarod mushers & parents:

Part of Alaska Airlines' sponsorship of the Iditarod includes a donation of tickets to the Iditarod to be used primarily for transportation of Iditarod personnel between Anchorage and Nome. The Iditarod gives tickets to the Jr. Iditarod to get the winner of the Jr. Iditarod and a guardian to and from Nome for the finish of the Iditarod.

These four one-way tickets are **not** just given outright to the winner of the Jr. Iditarod. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian of the race winner to contact me as soon as possible to arrange for getting the Jr. musher and **guardian** to and from Nome. Actually I don't have to make the reservations, **but I do have to approve the tickets for payment.** So if I am contacted immediately upon your making reservations with the record locator numbers of the two tickets, I can approve them and they will be available to you at time of travel as electronic tickets. You will need the record locator numbers and a picture ID to retrieve the tickets. (You will only retrieve one way at a time, so you'll have to use the same record locator in Nome to get your return ticket.)

These tickets will only be used to fly the winning musher and **guardian** to and from Nome. If the winning musher does not go to Nome for some reason, the tickets will not be available. If the winning musher does not fly to Nome, again the tickets will not be available. And finally, **the winning musher can not fly to Nome alone unless he or she has turned 18 by that time.**
